

Oliver Botar is a Professor of Art History at the University of Manitoba. His research focuses on early 20th century Central European Modernism with concentrations on art in alternative media, and 'Biocentrism' and Modernism in early-to-mid 20th century art. He also specializes in modern Hungarian and Canadian art more generally, and has lectured extensively in Europe, North America and Japan. Dr. Botar has been Resident Scholar at the Canadian Centre of Architecture (Montreal), a Fellow at the Institut Für Literaturwissenschaft (Berlin), and recipient of Standard Research Grant from the Social Sciences and Research Grant from the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council.
